California Water Service Company Donates \$136,750 to Local Organizations to Brighten Holidays for Disadvantaged

SAN JOSE, CA -- (Marketwired) -- 11/24/14 -- As part of its commitment to improve the quality of life in the communities it serves, California Water Service Company (Cal Water), the largest subsidiary of California Water Service Group (NYSE: CWT), is partnering with charitable organizations in each of its local service areas to help provide meals and services this holiday season to thousands of families in need through its annual Operation Gobble program.
